HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL WORKSHOPS BEST PRACTICE ONE DAY WORKSHOPS

Working with survivors of childhood abuse requires specialised training and can be challenging. Even though knowledge about the biological and interpersonal consequences of complex trauma has exploded over the past two decades, many training and treatment programs have not yet integrated the new information.

These one-day workshops are designed to help health professionals, including (but not limited to) counsellors, social workers, psychologists, mental health nurses, GP's and psychiatrists in their work with adult survivors

The workshop will cover:

- Understanding abuse and its impact
- Coping strategies and defence mechanisms used by survivors of child abuse
- Common impacts of child abuse
- Pathways through which adult health can be compromised
- Treatment models and best practice guidelines for working with adults surviving child abuse
